 - The increase was at least \$100, not due to improvements on the property.

<u>The Senior Citizen Deferral Program</u> provides a <u>low-interest loan</u> to senior citizens having difficulty paying property taxes. This is not a tax forgiveness program, however, this program:

- · Limits the maximum amount of property tax paid to 3% of total household income, and
- Ensures the amount of tax paid remains the same as long as you participate in this program.

To be eligible, you must file an application by November 1, 2023, as well as:

- 1. Be at least 65 years old,
- 2. Have a household income of \$60,000 or less, and
- 3. Have lived in your home for at least 15 years.
